SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 10

DISTRIBUTED GENERATION – NON-RESIDENTIAL (Cont'd)

Character of Service:

Natural gas with not less than 950 Btu per cubic foot, at pressures to be agreed upon, but not less than 4 inches water column. Service provided under this Service Classification shall not be subject to curtailment or interruption, except by reason of force majeure, and deliveries of firm service hereunder shall have priority over all deliveries to be made by company on an interruptible service basis.

Services Available:

The following services are available under this Service Classification:

Sales Service: For the continuous supply of natural gas by company including associated Gas Interconnection, Gas Transportation, Gas Supply, and Load Balancing services necessary to ensure delivery in accordance with customer's needs. For this service, the Gas Interconnection, Gas Transportation, Gas Supply, and Load Balancing Charges shall apply to all volumes through the meter.

Reserved Unbundled Transportation Service: For the continuous delivery of contract quantities of natural gas owned by customer (or by a party with a contract with customer to supply customer's natural gas requirements) from a contractually specified Point of Receipt to a contractually specified Point of Delivery where company's distribution system interconnects with the facilities of customer. Company reserves the right, acting reasonably, to limit the volume of gas that may be received at each Point of Receipt.

Customers purchasing their supplies from a Retail Supplier must use firm, non-recallable, primary delivery point capacity to the company's citygate(s) during the months of November to March. Customers or customers' Agent with transmission arrangements to Point of Receipt that are not for firm service on the upstream transmission pipeline system shall not in any Day take from company's distribution system more natural gas than the Authorized Daily Volume for such Day, unless customer has requested and received the prior approval of company to exceed the Authorized Daily Volume for such Day.

Customers or customers' Agent shall be responsible for obtaining the requisite regulatory approvals for the supply and transmission of customer's gas requirements to the Point of Receipt and, if applicable, for the export from Canada and the importation to the United States of such gas. Before any service under this provision shall be supplied, customer shall provide to company certified copies of all such approvals.
