ARTICLE IV – DAILY QUANTITIES AND MEASUREMENT

- 4.1 The maximum quantity of gas company is required to receive from customer in any Day at the Point of Receipt is ______ therms (the "Average Daily Transportation Quantity") and in any hour is one-twentieth (1/20) of such Average Daily Transportation Quantity.
- 4.2 The maximum volume of gas company is required to deliver to customer in any Day at the Point of Delivery shall be the sum of ____ cubic feet (the "Primary Service Classification Contract Volume") and ____ cubic feet (the "Secondary Service Classification Contract Volume") and any other Contract Volume, if applicable, to the Customer's Location.
- 4.3 The maximum volume of gas company is required to deliver to customer in any one hour period of time at the Point of Delivery shall be one-twentieth (1/20) of the aggregate of the daily volumes set forth in Section 4.2 above.
- 4.4 Any volume of gas received by the company at the Point of Receipt which is measured in cubic meters (m3) shall be converted to cubic feet (cf) at the rate of 35.30096 cf per m3 of gas.
- 4.5 Volumes of gas delivered at the Point of Delivery will be metered in cubic feet or multiples thereof. For purposes of billing, volumes of gas shall be converted to, or expressed in, therms based upon the system Btu content as measured by company from time to time.

ARTICLE V – RATES FOR TRANSPORTATION OF GAS

- 5.1 The rate(s) to be charged for the transportation of gas pursuant to this Service Agreement for a month shall be determined by reference to the rates applicable to the appropriate Service Classification for such month.
- 5.2 If, in any Day, gas is transported hereunder to the Point of Delivery pursuant to one or more numbered Service Classifications of company's tariff, the volume of gas delivered to customer shall consist of:
- a) first, deliveries under the Primary Service Classification up to the Primary Service Classification Contract Volume:
- b) secondly, deliveries under the Secondary Service Classification up to the Secondary Service Classification Contract Volume; and
- c) thirdly, deliveries under any other Service Classification up to the applicable Service Classification Volume.
