15. General Retail Access:

Street Lighting customers may elect Customer Advantage options and participate in General Retail Access in accordance with the provisions set forth in General Information Sections 12 (Customer Advantage Program) and 16 of Schedule P.S.C. 120 - Electricity.

16. Surcharge to Collect System Benefits Charge ("SBC")

The energy charges on customers' bills for service under Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, and 3 will be increased by multiplying all kilowatt-hours delivered by a surcharge to be determined annually. The surcharge is imposed pursuant to Commission Order Continuing and Expanding the System Benefits Charge for Public Benefit Programs, issued and effective January 26, 2001, in Case No. 94-E-0952. The surcharge will be calculated on an annual basis to collect the Corporation's allocated fund amount of \$21,645,000, based on year-by-year projections of the following year's electric sales. Any over or undercollections will be trued up on an annual basis. One-half the annual amount shall be collected during the first half of calendar year 2006. The surcharge will be effective with usage billed on and after March 3, 2001 through June 30, 2006.
