RATE - THREE PART - MONTHLY:

(1) <u>Transportation Charge</u>

Rate Schedule I: Applicable to:

- a) any customer that is a member of an aggregated group, or
- b) an individual customer whose annual usage is less than 5,000 Mcf.

Rate Schedule II:

Applicable to any customer that is not a member of an aggregated group and whose usage exceeds 5,000 Mcf in the previous consecutive twelve-month period. Customers using less than 5,000 Mcf in a consecutive twelve-month period shall be transferred to Rate Schedule I.

(2) <u>Balancing Service Option or Winter Bundled Sales Service Option</u>

Upon applying for firm transportation service under Service Classification No. 6, a customer must elect either the Balancing Service Option or Winter Bundled Sales Service Option.

(A) <u>Balancing Service Option</u>

The Balancing Service Option provides for a Seller to deliver gas to the Company's citygate on behalf of all of its customers in the Seller's Aggregation Group based on the customers' average daily usage for the same month last year, weather normalized and restated on a calendar month basis, with the Company redelivering the gas to the Seller's customers on an as needed basis. A customer selecting the Balancing Service Option shall be required to pay the Balancing Fee as set forth in 2(D) below.
