 - (d) Customers taking Interruptible Service for a portion of their load must take service for the Interruptible Load under the NYSEG Fixed Price Option (FPO). Such customers, if they choose to relinquish their Interruptible Service when permitted by that special tariff provision, may choose any rate for their entire load subject to Section 12, Customer Advantage Program.
 - (e) Customers who receive a portion of their Electric Power Supply from NYPA, (Expansion, EDP, HLFM, or PFJ), with Standard Load (non-NYPA load), shall be permitted to take service under any rate choice for their Standard Load subject to the provisions of Section 12, Customer Advantage Program. Such non-NYPA load will continue to be billed at the appropriate NYPA rate as specified in the Special Provision of Service Classification No. 7.
 - (f) Residential customers who take service under Special Provision (a) (Seasonal Service) of SC Nos. 1 or 8 are eligible only for the NYSEG Fixed Price Option (FPO) or ESCO Option with Supply Adjustment (EOSA) rates, as more fully described in Section 12 of this Schedule.
