1. Territory (County, Town, Development, Streets, etc.)

Moore Property Development (aka Four Corners Subdivision), Town of East Fishkill, County of Dutchess, State of New York.

## 2. Definitions - Water

- (a) "Backflow" Reversal of flow in a service.
- (b) "Casual Water" Water obtained in bulk (volume), on a case-by-case basis. Water may be provided to water haulers, sewer cleaners, et cetera, at approved rates for the specific Company.
- (c) "Construction Water" Water used through a service during new construction prior to setting the water meter. Such water is normally used for mixing mortar, construction activity, et cetera, but not for landscape watering.
- (d) "Cross Connection" Any connection or condition allowing actual or potential reversal of flow in a service and/or contamination of the potable plumbing systems.
- (e) "Curb Stop" A shut-off valve on the service for control of water to the customer normally located between the curb and property line.
- (f) "Customer" Any authorized person, agency, corporation or other property owners or governmental jurisdiction having access to, using or permitting the use of water through service. The customer's responsibilities under the Rules and Regulations cannot be transferred, assigned or otherwise diminished for water service whether or not such property owner or governmental jurisdiction actually consumed or used the water. Owner's of residential rental units or individual homes being rented are responsible for all water usage charges and the up keep of all water service pipes, meters, and shut offs as described in this document. Specifically, payments for water usage shall be the sole responsibility of the owner as listed on the tax roles and said bills shall be delivered to said property owners.
  - (g) "Excavator" Any person licensed and bonded to do service work.
- (h) "Main Extension" The construction of additional public water main to serve water customers. Construction normally occurs in public right-of-way or easements.
  - (i) "Plumber" A master plumber licensed in the County of Dutchess to do plumbing or service work.
  - (j) "Service" A pipe used to convey water to the customer from a water main.
  - (k) "Street Valve" A shut-off valve on larger services normally located near the water main.
  - (1) "Tap" Opening in the water main allowing water to be passed into the customer's service.
  - (m) "Water Distribution System" The network of water mains and related appurtenances.
- (n) "Water Main" Large pipe used to convey water through the distribution system to normally more than one customer.
  - (o) "Water Service" The availability of water through service.

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
