(2) Other withdrawable customers must maintain reserve levels acceptable to the Company.

A customer with an inadequate alternate fuel reserve that fails to discontinue gas service at any time during the first 10 days in which the Company has requested customer to discontinue usage of gas service in any winter season shall be billed an additional charge equal to the greater of a) 130% of the cost of its alternate fuel, as established with reference to appropriate fuel price indices as determined in accordance with the Company's Gas Transportation Operating Procedures or b) 130% of the rates charged by the Company for service under this Service Classification, minus the rates paid by the customer under this Service Classification. Any customer with an inadequate alternate fuel reserve as of November 1 of each year will similarly be subject to the same additional charge. This additional charge shall be applied to all gas consumed during the billing period in which there is non-compliance and for any subsequent billing periods during which the non-compliance continues.
