TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills are due when rendered. Full payment must be received on or before the date shown on the bill to avoid a late payment charge of 1.5% as provided in Rule VIII of the NYMPA generic tariff.

PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT:

The charges set forth in this service classification shall be subject to a purchased power adjustment as explained in Rule IX of the NYMPA generic tariff.

TERM:

Service is terminable on three days notice at any time after one month's service provided that a customer is not subject to Special Provisions, Section B.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- A. Any customer who desires service for multiple dwelling (two or more families in one house or where, more than two rooms are rented) or for premises partially used for business, or professional and partially used for residential purposes, may secure service only under Service Classification No. 2.
- B. When it appears to the Village that the service may be of a seasonal or temporary character, the Village will require prepayment at the time the application for service is made, of the net minimum charge for the entire six months' term. Such advance payment will be refunded by crediting \$3.05 on each of the first six months' bills. If service is discontinued before the expiration of the six months' term, the unrefunded portion will be retained by the Village.
