17. PRECAUTIONS TO BE TAKEN BY CUSTOMER:

A customer shall take due care to prevent any waste of gas. The responsibility of detection of defects and leaks on the customer's premises and in the service line owned by the customer, is upon the customer; defects among other things, shall mean failure or deficiency of gas, irregular supply, leakage and excessive pressure. In case of detection of a leak within his premises, the customer shall immediately shut off the gas at the meter, extinguish all flames, or fires within the premises, open all doors and windows to permit the escape of gas, and at once notify the Company by telephone or messenger, so that the conditions existing may receive prompt and proper attention. When gas has been shut off because of leak in house lines or fixtures or other hazardous conditions of service, it shall not be turned on again until such leak or other hazardous conditions have been repaired and made safe by a competent plumber. Gas service shall not be resumed to the premises until all requirements have been met and the lines have been inspected, tested, and approved by the Company. In the event of failure or deficiency of gas or excessive pressure, the customer shall shut off gas at meter, notify Company and be governed by instructions or assistance received from the Company.
