Within each of the preceding service characteristics, the Customer shall contract for either a Monthly or Fixed Price, as described below:

Monthly Price:

This price will be applicable to customers who contract for Interruptible Sales Service, at monthly prices, as specified on the Interruptible Rate Statement.

Fixed Price:

The Customer may contract for a Fixed Price for a period of up to five (5) years. Such price shall be stated on the Interruptible Rate Statement, and may be adjusted monthly for changes in the cost of gas, applicable taxes and other surcharges as may be provided by the Service Agreement, as directed by the PSC or other governing authority, or prices may be fixed with no provisions for adjustment. During the term of the Service Agreement, the Customer may not take service under the Monthly Price except at the sole discretion of the Company.

NOTIFICATION OF PRICE:

The Interruptible Rate Statement will be filed with the PSC no later than three (3) days before the effective date.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The Minimum Charge shall be based on a minimum quantity of 4,000 Dth per billing month delivered to the Customer and priced at the currently applicable price per Dth and other supplemental charges.

In case of: (i) complete suspension of operations at Customer's premises for a period of not less than seven (7) consecutive days in any billing month due to causes not within Customer's control; or (ii) Customer being subject to the Minimum Charge due to the extent of service interruption by the Company, Customer shall be billed and pay an amount calculated by billing the quantity of gas actually consumed during such billing month at the then currently effective rate.
