#### 6. INSTALLATION OF MAINS, SERVICE CONNECTIONS AND FACILITIES AND EXTENSIONS: (CONT'D)

##### F. Inspection, Maintenance and Replacement of Facilities: (Cont'd)

- (2) The Company shall bear the cost of inspecting, testing and operating all facilities. It shall bear the cost of maintaining, replacing or reconstructing all main and appurtenant facilities. It shall also bear the cost of maintaining, replacing or reconstructing the service line and appurtenant facilities necessary to serve each as if each customer were an applicant for service, unless an act or omission of the customer necessitates the replacement or reconstruction.
- (3) If an act or omission of any customer who had installed facilities necessitates the replacement or reconstruction of such facilities, the customer shall pay to the Company the cost of replacement or reconstruction.

#### 7. MAINTENANCE OF HOUSE LINES:

All house lines shall be kept and maintained in good condition by the Customer or owner. When leaky or hazardous conditions of the house lines are found, repairs shall be made promptly by the Customer or owner.

#### 8. TESTING AND INSPECTING CUSTOMER'S SERVICE:

In instances where gas service is to be rendered at a location for the first time or where gas service is to be resumed at a location after repair or remodeling of service lines or house lines, such service line and house piping of the Customer must be tested and inspected, prior to the introduction of gas service, in accordance with the Company's "Requirements and Specifications Governing the Installation and Maintenance of Gas Service Piping, House Piping, Meter and Regulator Settings, Appliance Venting on Customer's Premises".

#### 9. METER LOCATION:

The Customer will provide space to be selected by the Company for the meter, pipes and other equipment belonging to the Company, and shall protect them when located. Where feasible, the meter setting will be installed outdoors or remote registers for all new one-, two-, and three-family houses will be installed by the Company.
