SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 7 (CONT'D)

ALTERNATE FUEL DISPLACEMENT SERVICE (CONT'D)

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

The Maximum Daily Quantity (MDQ) available for delivery pursuant to this service classification shall not exceed Buyer's installed non-peak alternate fuel capability and shall be within:

- (A) The limits imposed by the curtailment and daily interruption provisions governing the otherwise applicable service classification; or
- (B) The limit imposed by Buyer's effective MDQ entitlement under the Company's otherwise applicable firm service classification.
- (C) The term of the agreement for service under this service classification shall be for a minimum of one (1) year and shall be automatically renewed each year unless written notice to terminate is given by the Buyer or the Company not less than sixty (60) days prior to the expiration date of the agreement.

PRICE:

At the Company's sole discretion, a charge per therm shall be established by the Company which shall be no less than the current market price of gas to be sold to these customers based on information received during the bid period for the following month plus \$0.01 per Therm.

The Company shall notify customers serviced under this service classification of the price to be effective for each month. Such notice will be given to customers, and filed with the PSC, not less than three (3) business days prior to the beginning of the month for which the price will be in effect.

MINIMUM CHARGE (Per Month):

The Minimum Charge provision of the service classification underlying the Customer's contract to purchase remains in full force and effect. Quantities delivered under this Schedule shall be considered under the Buyer's applicable service classification for minimum bill computation.
