**SEASONAL GAS COOLING SERVICE (CONT'D)**

**MINIMUM CHARGE:**

The Minimum Charge is the charge for the first 3 Therms or less, per meter.

**INCREASE IN PRICES APPLICABLE IN MUNICIPALITIES WHERE SERVICE IS SUPPLIED:**

The prices and charges under this service classification, including the Minimum Charge, will be increased by a surcharge pursuant to General Information Section 37 of this Schedule, to reflect the tax rates applicable to service within the municipality where the Customer takes service.

**BILLING QUANTITY:**

The quantity of gas billed under this service classification shall be metered separately from all other natural gas consumption.

**TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

All bills are due and subject to a late payment charge in accordance with the applicable provisions of General Information Section 33 of this Schedule.

**TERM:**

One (1) month and thereafter until terminated by forty-eight (48) hours' notice.

**SPECIAL PROVISIONS:**

A. Balanced Billing:

Customers may, by completing an application, be billed monthly in accordance with the plan set forth in Section 8.Q. of PSC No. 30 Gas, or superseding issues thereof.

B. Gas Used October Through April:

All gas used during the period October through April of each year shall be in accordance with the prices and provisions of the service classification applicable to the Customer's gas usage which is not for gas cooling or dessicant dehumidifying equipment.
