In addition to the requirements specified above, for the winter season (November-March) a customer taking the Daily Delivery Service shall present documentation to the Company that there is in place one or more executed transportation contract(s) with one or more interstate pipeline(s) for transportation or storage and associated transportation to the Citygate dedicated to deliveries for the Customer's account for the difference between the highest anticipated Daily Load Quantity the Customer is required to deliver and the daily quantities specified in the foregoing paragraphs. Such transportation and storage must be non-recallable firm with primary delivery point capacity to the Citygate.

The highest anticipated Daily Load Quantity shall be determined by the Company on the basis of the Customer's historical usage and design weather conditions.

Any Customer that selects Capacity Release Service at less than the Maximum Quantity shall meet the winter season requirements of the foregoing paragraphs for the difference between the Maximum Quantity and the Quantity of Capacity Release Service elected.

To the extent applicable, the Customer shall provide the same documentation upon renewal of its Firm Service Classification No. 9 Service.

If a Customer does not elect Capacity Release Service when the Customer first elects Firm Transportation service, the Company shall have no obligation to provide Capacity Release Service to the Customer at any future time, but may do so in its sole discretion.
