16. QUANTITY LIMITATIONS AND CURTAILMENT PROVISIONS: (CONT'D)

- G. Emergency Electric Generation: (Cont'd)
 - (2) The customer will be required to pay for all additional installation costs associated with emergency electric generation service including mains and service laterals and metering if required.
 - (3) When the Company has sales restrictions, customers with emergency electric generation will be penalized for excessive usage. Excessive usage will occur when the customer exceeds his existing annual limitation for other uses plus an annual emergency electric generation allotment allowing one-half hour testing each week and estimated use during a verifiable power outage. Any use in excess of this new annual limitation will be billed, where appropriate, at the maximum tariff penalty for unauthorized use.
- H. Minimum Insulation Standards for the Provision of Gas Service:

The Company shall refuse service to all applicants for new gas service at facilities that do not meet the Minimum Insulation Standards as prescribed in the insulation guidelines on file with the PSC.

- Gas service will not be provided to a new dwelling, or to an existing dwelling for the purpose of converting to gas space heating, unless the dwelling is in compliance with Part 233 of 16 NYCRR
 Minimum Insulation Standards for the provision of gas and electric service. Copies of the minimum standards are available at Company offices.
- (2) An applicant for gas service to a new residential dwelling in a locality where building permits are not required must provide to the Company a Certificate of Compliance shown below:
