SPECIAL PROVISIONS - ALL CUSTOMERS:

- A. All service provided under this transportation service classification will be subject to interruption, at the Company's sole discretion, in accordance with General Information Section 8 of this Schedule. Customers that fail to comply with a notification to interrupt shall pay a penalty, in addition to all other prices and charges payable by said customer, of \$2.50 per therm for all quantities consumed in violation of the notification, as determined by the Company.
 - B. Customer's equipment supplied hereunder should have an alternative source of fuel, however this requirement may be waived by written permission of the Company. The Company reserves the right to conduct an onsight inspection of the Customer's alternate fuel facilities at any time to determine whether the equipment is properly installed, maintained, functioning and capable of serving the Customer's energy requirements at a level equivalent to that of the natural gas provided under this service classification. Equipment supplied under this service classification, may be transferred to an applicable firm service classification with the written permission of the Company. However, any such equipment can not be resupplied under an interruptible service classification prior to the elapse of a minimum period of one (1) year.
 - C. The quantity to be billed under this service classification is the quantity delivered to the Company less the allowance for losses, in accordance with General Information Section 4.E. of this Schedule.
 - D. Daily imbalances, underruns and overruns under this service classification will be calculated and reconciled as set forth in General Information Section 4 of this Schedule.
 - E. A Transportation Service Agreement shall be signed by both parties in the form set forth in General Information Section 13 of this Schedule.
