29.ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT MECHANISM

System Benefits Charge (SBC)

The System Benefits Charge will be applied to the kWh usage on the bills of all full service and delivery service customers served under this Schedule. The SBC factor will be determined annually and be designed to recover the costs of research and development, energy efficiency, environmental protection, and low income program approved for SBC funding by the Public Service Commission.

Nine Mile Point 2 Competitive Transition Charge (NMP2 CTC)

The NMP2 CTC is designed to recover O&M, taxes and capital costs associated with the Company's ownership share of NMP2. The NMP2 CTC will be applied to the Kwh usage on the bills of all full service and delivery service customers served under this Schedule. The charge is non-bypassable and will be assessed to all customers on a per Kwh basis.

Statement of Energy Cost Adjustment Mechanism Factors

The Purchased Power Recovery Charge Factor, Variable Delivery Charge Factor, Systems Benefits Charge and Nine Mile Point 2 Competitive Transition Charge Factors shall be determined monthly to be in effect for service rendered during the following billing month. The factors so determined shall remain in effect until charged as authorized by the Public Service Commission.

Not less the three business days prior to a proposed changed in the Statement of Energy Cost Mechanism Factors, a statement sharing each factor and the effective date will be filed with the Public Service Commission. Such statement shall be made available to the public at Company offices.
