Special Provisions

The Company reserves all of its rights and remedies in connection with customers who are delinquent in sums owed to the Company for Company charges or who have otherwise failed to comply with their obligations under the Tariff. The Company agrees to provide the Marketer with notice of the Company*s disconnection of any customer for non-payment or for other violations of the Tariff on the day after the Company effectuates disconnection. The Company shall have no liability whatsoever to the Marketer, or to any third party who is a supplier or other contracting party with Marketer, for any loss of revenue or any other losses or damages resulting from any other losses or damages resulting from the Company*s disconnection of any customer. The Company will continue to comply with all the provisions of HEFPA as applicable for any service termination.
