### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### SECTION VIII. EXTENSION OF MAINS

##### 2. Public Street - Within Seventy-five (75) Feet - Owner or Occupant

Whenever an owner or occupant of any property abutting on any public street, as hereinbefore defined (Section VIII(1)), within seventy-five (75) feet of any Company-owned main appropriate to the service requested, makes a written application for service, the Company will extend its mains at its own cost and expense so as to serve said property.

##### 3. Public Street - Over Seventy-five (75) Feet - Owner or Occupant

Whenever an owner or occupant of any property abutting on any public street, hereinbefore defined (Section VIII (1)), in which there is no Company-owned water main appropriate to the service requested, within a distance of seventy-five (75) feet from said property, makes a written application for service, the Company will extend its mains in accordance with the terms of the AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION Surcharge Required (see Leaf 50) provided that (1) said applicant furnishes assurance satisfactory to the Company that he will be a reasonably permanent customer and (2) said applicant furnishes reasonable security as to the performance of his agreement (Section VIII (7)).

##### 4. Public Street-Prospective Owner or Prospective Occupants

An applicant who cannot qualify as a reasonably permanent customer may be required to deposit the entire cost of the main extension and installed services with the Company. The applicant shall be entitled to a refund, without interest, of the deposit as prescribed by 16 NYCRR §501.8 within thirty (30) days of taking service and demonstrating reasonable permanency. The applicant shall also be required to execute an agreement with the Company in such form as provided in Leaf 52.1.

##### 5. Private Streets - More Than One Premise

Whenever an applicant makes written application for water service to more than one premise located on a private street, as hereinbefore defined (Section VIII (1)), the Company will extend its mains in accordance with the terms of AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION Company Performed Installation (see Leaf 53) or AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION Applicant Performed Installation (See Leaf 57).
