NATURAL GAS MOTOR VEHICLES (CONT'D)

INCREASE IN PRICES APPLICABLE IN MUNICIPALITY WHERE SERVICE IS SUPPLIED:

The prices and charges under this service classification, including the Minimum Charge, will be increased by a surcharge pursuant to General Information Section 37 of this Schedule to reflect the tax rates applicable within the municipality where the Customer takes service.

Any Federal, State and/or Local taxes required to be collected by the Company on sales of natural gas for use in motor vehicles shall be charged for all sales made hereunder.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills are due and subject to a late payment charge in accordance with General Information Section 33 of this Schedule.

TERM:

One (1) month and thereafter until terminated by forty-eight (48) hours' written notice.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

1. For Category 1 customers, the expense of installing facilities necessary to separately meter service provided hereunder shall be borne by the Customer.
2. Gas supplied hereunder may, under certain circumstances, contain a mixture of natural gas and liquified petroleum gas.
3. Gas service supplied at Company-owned and operated compressor stations is subject to the Company's sole determination that sufficient capacity exists at its compressor stations to adequately serve Company and Customer Natural Gas Vehicle requirements.
4. The Company reserves the right to accept an application under this service classification as will, at the Company's sole judgement, permit it to sell the gas it has available for sale without requiring any extension of or additions to its compressor station facilities located on Company premises. In no event will the Company be obligated hereunder to construct additional compressor stations.
