APPLICABLE TO USE OF SERVICE FOR:

Small General Service inside the Village of Skaneateles for customers with energy use less than 6000 kwh and less than 20 kw during all winter months from November through April. If a customer's energy use equals or exceeds 6000 kwh or demand equals or exceeds 20 kw during any said winter month, that customer will be moved to Service Class 3 for a minimum of 12 months.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Continuous, Alternating Current, nominal 60 Cycle, single phase three wire 120/240 volt; three phase three wire 240 volt; three phase four wire 208 volt. (Voltage at option of Village)

TERMS OF PAYMENT

All bills are due when personally served or three days after the mailing of the bill and may be paid without imposition of a charge for late payment if paid in full on or before the "last day to pay" date specified on the bill which shall be at least 15 days after the date on which the bill is rendered.

LATE PAYMENT CHARGES

A monthly late payment charge will be assessed at the rate of one and one half percent (1½%) per month on a customer's unpaid balance, including service billing arrears and unpaid late payment charges. Remittance mailed on the "last day to pay" date will be accepted without the late payment charge, the postmark to be conclusive evidence of the date of mailing. The failure on the part of the customer to receive the bill shall not entitle him/her to pay without the late payment charge after the "last day to pay" date.
