SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 3 (CONT'D)

DETERMINATION OF DEMAND:

The active demand shall be the maximum fifteen-minute integrated-kilowatt demand. For billing purposes, the demand shall be the greatest of the following:

1. The demand occurring during the month for which the charge is made.
2. One-half (1/2) the highest demand occurring during any of the preceding eleven (11) months.
3. During initial term, the demand contracted for.
4. Fifty (50) kilowatts.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills are due when personally served or three (3) days after the mailing if the bill and may be paid without imposition of a charge for late payment if paid in full on or before the "pay gross after" date specified on the bill which shall be at least twenty (20) days after the date on which the bill is rendered.

A monthly late payment charge will be assessed at a rate of one and one-half percent (1½%) per month on the customer's unpaid balance, including service billing arrears and unpaid late-payment charges. Remittance mailed on the "pay gross after" date will be accepted without the late payment, the United States postmark to be conclusive evidence of the date of mailing. The failure on the part of the customer to receive the bill shall not entitle him/her to pay without the late-payment charge after the "pay gross after" date.

PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT:

The charges set forth in this service classification shall be subject to a purchased power adjustment as explained in the NYMPA generic tariff.

The charges billed under this section shall be subject to the late-payment rate.
