SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 2 (CONT'D)

CONDITION:

Energy use shall be less than 3500 kilowatt hours and less than 15 kilowatts during all of the winter months from November through April inclusive. If either energy use equals or exceeds 3500 kilowatt hours or demand equal to or exceeds 15 kilowatts during any said winter months, then Service Classification No. 3 shall apply for the twelve (12) next consecutive months.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

All bills are due when personally served or three days after mailing of the bill and may be paid in full on or before the last day of the month after mailing, said date being the "DUE DATE". A monthly late payment charge will be assessed at a rate of one and one-half percent (1-1/2%) on a customer's unpaid balance including service billing arrears and unpaid late payment charges. Remittance mailed on the "DUE DATE" will be accepted without the late charge) the postmark to be conclusive evidence of the date of mailing. The failure on the part of the customer to receive the bill shall not entitle him/her to pay without the late payment charge after the "DUE DATE".
