GENERAL INFORMATION

14. GAS SUPPLY CHARGE (GSC):

- A. Applicability
 - (1) Effective October 1, 2002, the GSC will be applicable to all customers taking service pursuant to Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 5, 8 and 9 of PSC No. 87 Gas, or superseding issues thereof.
 - (2) The applicable GSC, per Therm of usage, will be charged to customer's by prorating the GSCs in effect during the billing period based on the number of days each GSC was in effect during the billing period.
- B. Monthly GSC Calculation
 - (1) The GSCs will be calculated on a monthly basis.
 - (2) A monthly GSC will be calculated for each applicable service classification of each Rate Area. Each GSC will be a function of the applicable Gas Supply Area (GSA). The GSAs and applicable Rate Areas are:

<u>Gas Supply Area</u> <u>Rate Area</u> GSA 1 Combined, Elmira, Goshen and Champlain GSA 2 Binghamton and Owego GSA 3

Lockport

- (3) Each monthly GSC will be the sum of the Total Average Cost of Gas, the Supplier Refund Adjustment, the Research and Development (R&D) Adjustment, the Annual Reconciliation Adjustment, the Interim Reconciliation Adjustment and other PSC approved adjustments.
- C. The Total Average Cost of Gas is: (1) the sum of the Average Demand Cost of Gas, the Average Commodity Cost of Gas and the Gas Cost Savings Adjustments; multiplied by the product of the Load Factor Adjustment (LFA) and the Factor of Adjustment (FA); plus (2) the Merchant Function Charge (MFC).
