DETERMINATION OF AGGREGATED DAILY CONTRACT QUANTITY: (Cont'd.)

adjustments from prior months, and will adjust the ADCQ for a succeeding month by that difference divided by the total number of days in the month, provided that such adjustment will neither increase that month's adjusted ADCQ to a level greater than the Seller's single highest ADCQ for the year ("MAX ADCQ") nor decrease that month's adjusted ADCQ to a level less than zero. The increment of any such adjustments that results in a particular month's ADCQ being greater than the MAX ADCQ or less than zero will be carried to a future month.

CAPACITY RELEASE:

Sellers who wish to provide gas supplies to customers served by the Company pursuant to Service Classification No. 6 will be required to contract for a portion of the Company's firm pipeline capacity and abide by the nomination procedures established herein. Seller shall be allocated firm pipeline capacity each month equal to its MAX ADCQ. Seller's cost responsibility shall be equal to the Company's monthly weighted average cost of firm pipeline capacity. Seller shall receive, on a monthly basis, either a credit or surcharge reflecting the difference between the interstate pipelines' maximum firm transportation rates and the Company's weighted average cost of firm pipeline capacity. The Company shall retain recall rights to such capacity in the event of non-performance by Seller as specified in Special Provision C below.

NOMINATION PROCEDURES:

Seller shall be required to abide by the Nomination Procedures established below:

- (1) Prior to the 10th of the month, each customer must notify the Company of its Seller for deliveries to commence on the 1st of the following month.
- (2) By the 10th of each month, Seller must inform the Company of all customers in its Aggregation Group for deliveries to commence on the 1st of the following month.
- (3) By the 15th of each month, the Company will provide an ADCQ to Seller.
- (4) By the 15th of each month, the Company will notify Seller of firm pipeline capacity path.
- (5) By the 17th of each month, Seller must notify the Company of any changes or corrections to its Aggregation Group.
