SPECIAL PROVISIONS: (Cont'd.)

(C) <u>Availability</u>

Service under this rate schedule is available only to those customers being served prior to December 22, 1972 and only at the location of such service prior to December 22, 1972.

(D) Emergency Service

If during a period of interruption a customer is unable to secure customer's alternate fuel or customer's alternate fuel equipment becomes inoperable, the Company, upon the request of said customer, and at its sole discretion, may elect to serve said customer to the extent it deems possible. This provision does not express or imply any guarantee of service nor does it release any customer from any other provision of this tariff. Service rendered under this provision may be terminated at any time at the Company's option upon not less than two hours notice. The charge for service rendered under this provision will be as follows:

- (1) All Mcf @ \$6.28 per Mcf; plus
- (2) The Monthly Adjustment, in dollars per Mcf, will be equal to the Base Cost of Propane, \$0.50 per gallon, subtracted from the monthly Average Inventory Cost of Propane, in dollars per gallon, multiplied by a Conversion Factor of 10.8983, except that if said adjustment is less than zero, no adjustment shall be applied; plus
- (3) Part (2) of RATE TWO PART MONTHLY as stated above.

The adjustment as provided for above shall be calculated monthly, shall be effective commencing with the first cycle of the billing month following the computation date, and shall continue in effect until changed. The monthly Average Inventory Cost of Propane shall be determined by the Company each month by dividing the total dollar value of the Company's propane inventory by the total gallons on hand for all of the Company's propane facilities.

Not less than three days prior to any change in the adjustment, a statement showing the calculation of the adjustment shall be filed with the Commission and shall be available for public inspection at Company offices where applications for service may be made.
