**SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 3 (Cont'd.)****STATEMENT OF INTERRUPTIBLE GAS RATES:**

Not less than three working days prior to the first day of each billing period, the Company shall file with the Commission a statement showing the Maximum Allowable Unit Charge, the Minimum Allowable Unit Charge, the actual Unit Charges to be billed, the Difference and the Effective Charges, including Part (2) of RATE - TWO PART - MONTHLY, as provided for above.

**MINIMUM CHARGE:**

None.

**TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

Bills are due when rendered, subject to a late payment charge in accordance with the provisions of General Information Section 6.6.

**TERM:**

One year and successive annual periods thereafter until terminated by the customer at the end of any contract year upon not less than ninety (90) days prior notice in writing to the Company; terminable by the Company upon like notice to the customer; also terminable by the Company in the manner provided by law and provisions of this rate schedule.

**SPECIAL PROVISIONS:****(A) Metering**

The unit of measurement shall be a cubic foot of gas at an absolute pressure of fourteen and seventy-three one-hundredths pounds (14.73#) per square inch, a temperature of sixty degrees (60E) Fahrenheit and without adjustment for water vapor content. In determining the volume of gas delivered, the Average Absolute Atmospheric (Barometric) Pressure shall be assumed to be fourteen and four-tenths pounds (14.4#) to the square inch, irrespective of actual elevation or location of the delivery point above sea level or variations in actual barometric pressure from time to time.

**(B) Supply**

Gas supplied hereunder is in addition to and not a part of the Company's system requirements. During the term of the Order dated October 26, 1971, as amended on December 14, 1971, of the Public Service Commission Case 25766, a customer served under the rate schedule may not shift to any other rate schedule to effect any change in availability of gas to his premises.
