Interim Recovery of Gas Supplier Take or Pay Charges -Commencing April 1, 1989, all volumes used under this Service Classification shall be assessed surcharges calculated according to the Stipulation and Resolution of Issues approved by the New York State Public Service Commission in Case No. 88-G-062. The Take or Pay Surcharges are designed to collect, subject to refund, a certain portion of Take or Pay Charges currently being billed to the Company by interstate pipelines, as well as a certain portion of Take or Pay Charges heretofore deferred. The Take or Pay Surcharges will be shown as separate line items in the Statement of Adjustments to Firm Transportation Service Rates as filed with the Commission each month.
- b. Interim Recovery of FERC Order 636 Transition Costs - All volumes used under this Service Classification shall be assessed a surcharge calculated according to the New York State Public Service Commission's Opinion and Order Establishing Regulatory Policies and Guidelines for Natural Gas Distributors, Opinion 94-26 in Case 93-G-0932, issued and effective December 20, 1994. The FERC Order 636 Transition Costs will be shown as a separate line item in the Statement of Adjustments to Firm Transportation Service Rates as filed with the Commission each month.
- c. All volumes used under this Service Classification shall be assessed the Credit/Surcharge for Interruptible and Firm Dual Fuel Sales and Transportation Service Benefits as determined in General Information Section 12. The Credit/Surcharge for Interruptible and Firm Dual Fuel Sales and Transportation Service Benefits will be shown as a separate line item in the Statement of Adjustments to Firm Transportation Service Rates as filed with the Commission each month.
- d. During the period October 1 through May 31 of each year, all volumes of gas used under this Service Classification shall be assessed the Weather Normalization Adjustment pursuant to General Information Section 12.3.
- e. All rates and charges under this Service Classification will be increased pursuant to General Information Section 15.
