SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 4 (Cont'd.)**RATE - FOUR PART - MONTHLY: (Cont'd.)****(3) Penalty and Overrun Charges**

All gas delivered to a customer in excess of the amount delivered to the Company for customer's account shall be subject to the following penalty and/or overrun charges:

- (a) During periods when the customer fails to interrupt service as requested by the Company, excess gas delivered shall be charged at the rate for Emergency Interruptible Service as provided for in Service Classification No. 3.
- (b) At all other times, excess gas delivered shall be charged at Service Classification No. 2 rates, including the gas adjustment charge.

(4) Increase in Rates and Charges

- (a) Interim Recovery of Gas Supplier Take or Pay Charges - Commencing April 1, 1989, all rates under this Service Classification shall include surcharges calculated according to the Stipulation and Resolution of Issues approved by the New York State Public Service Commission in Case No. 88-G-062. The Take or Pay Surcharges are designed to collect, subject to refund, a certain portion of Take or Pay charges currently being billed to the Company by interstate pipeline suppliers, as well as a certain portion of Take or Pay charges heretofore deferred. The Take or Pay surcharges will be shown as separate line items in the Statement of Interruptible Transportation Service Rates as filed with the Commission each month. Customers who commenced service hereunder prior to April 1, 1989 shall, for the twelve-month period beginning April 1, 1989, be charged the TOP surcharges in addition to the applicable transportation charge.
- (b) The rates and charges under this Service Classification, including the transportation charge, ULIEEP surcharge, penalty and overrun charges and the minimum charge, will be increased pursuant to General Information Section 15.
