The Take or Pay Surcharge is designed to collect, subject to refund, a certain portion of Take or Pay charges currently being billed to the Company by interstate pipeline suppliers, as well as a certain portion of Take or Pay charges heretofore deferred and will be shown on the Statement of Gas Adjustment filed with the Commission.
