Not less than three working days prior to the first day of each billing period, the Company shall file, with the Commission, a statement showing the adjustments to firm transportation charges, as provided for above.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Bills are due when rendered, subject to a late payment charge in accordance with the provisions of General Information Section 6.6.

TERM:

One year and successive annual periods thereafter until terminated by the customer at the end of any contract year upon not less than ninety days prior notice in writing to the Company; terminable by the Company upon like notice to the customer; also terminable by the Company as provided for in Special Provision D.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- (A) Customer will be provided with a Firm Transportation Information Package from the Company which describes the process necessary for the customer to obtain a Qualified Seller of natural gas. In addition, the customer will be required to sign a Service Agreement with the Company governing the terms and conditions of transportation service.
- (B) The customer is required to notify the Company of its Seller prior to the tenth of each month for deliveries to commence on the first of the next month, and such selection shall remain in effect for the entire month. The customer will be permitted to select a new Seller once during a twelve month period at no charge. The customer shall pay an administrative fee of \$25 for each additional change of Seller during a twelve month period.
- (C) Balancing Use

During each of the billing months of November through March, if the average daily usage of gas in any month exceeds the average daily usage during the preceding billing months of June through September ("Average Daily Summer Usage"), the volume used in such month in excess of the product of the Average Daily Summer Usage times the number of days in the billing month shall be subject to the Balancing Charge. For new customers and for customers who install additional gas burning equipment, the Average Daily Summer Usage to be used in the above calculation shall be estimated by the Company.
