2.8 ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION DISCOUNT (Cont'd)

Audits

Qualifying audit recommendations that require high cost capital improvements will upon request of the customer, be evaluated on a case by case basis. The provisions of General Information Section 29 shall apply to electricity provided and sold by the Company under this Service Classification. Customers participating in the Retail Access Program as described in General Information Section 35 shall not be subject to this charge.

Qualifying Locations

Locations which qualify for the discount will be identified by the Company and updated every six months. A list of qualifying locations will be provided to the Public Service Commission and the New York State Department of Economic Development.

Customers will not be eligible to commence taking service under this Special Provision after June 30, 2001.

2.9 POWER FOR JOBS

Eligibility

Service under this special provision will only be available to customers who receive an allocation of power under the Power for Jobs program. A Power for Jobs allocation is power and energy made available by the New York Power Authority (PASNY) to the Company for resale to designated Customers in accordance with Chapter 316 of the 1997 Laws of New York.

Application for Service

A customer who receives an allocation of Power for Jobs must have an account established under the Company's tariff. PASNY must advise the Company when a Power for Jobs allocation has been approved and provide the Company with a copy of the Allocation Contract. The notification by PASNY to the Company that the Customer has received a Power for Jobs allocation shall constitute the acceptance and the terms and conditions of this
