- (n) The amount consumed between present and previous readings.
- (o) The amount owed for the latest period.
- (p) The date by which payments for the latest period may be paid without penalty.
- (q) The penalty charge for late paid bills.
- (r) Credits from past bills and any amounts owed and unpaid from previous bills.
- (s) An explanation of any abbreviation or symbol used that is not common English usage.
- (2) For budget billing plans, the following additional information must be displayed:
  - (a) The total of the budget bills rendered from the beginning of the budget plan year to the end of the period covered by the current bill.
  - (b) The amount of the difference between the budget plan and the actual charges.
  - (c) The debit or credit balance.
- (3) For non-residential bills, the following information must be displayed:
  - (a) The address and location of the premises where the service was supplied.
- d. Billing Performance Standards

Suppliers are required to meet the same billing standards applied to the Company by the Commission. Such standard requirements shall be provided in the transportation procedures manual.

9. Customer Aggregation Billing Service

Supplier may elect the Company's Customer Aggregation Billing Service ("CABS"). By electing CABS, Supplier agrees to permit the Company to perform all retail billing functions for Supplier's STBA Customers, including invoicing, remittance processing and customer service activities. CABS is available to all Suppliers who execute a CABS Agreement. The Company is authorized to reduce Supplier's security requirement for STBA service to the extent that the Company's exposure is modified by providing CABS for the Supplier, and further if payment of STBA invoices is guaranteed by the Supplier's portion of revenues collected from Customers and held by the Company.
