Existing Core Customer - A Core Customer taking service under Service Classification No. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BI, 1BR, 2, 3, 4A, 4B, 7 or 11 (Rate Schedules TS-2, TS-4A or TS-4B) as of May 1, 1996.

New Core Customer - Any Core Customer who or that is not an Existing Core Customer.

Core Customer- A customer lacking energy alternatives. A Core Customer takes either (a) firm sales service, and lacks installed equipment capable of burning fuels other than gas; or (b) firm transportation service under Service Classification No. 16 or 17.

Maximum Daily Delivery Quantity (MDDQ) - The maximum quantity of gas that Customer <u>may</u> <u>be required</u> to deliver on any day to the Company for transportation by the Company to the Customer on that day pursuant to Customer's CTB service agreement. Such quantity shall be subject to the limitations, restrictions and other provisions contained herein.

Load Profile Factor - The Customer's maximum month's normalized consumption, divided by the minimum month's consumption minus one, all calculated as per Company records. The minimum load profile will never be less than one; the maximum load profile will never be greater than eight.

Actual Monthly ICOG - The actual monthly incremental cost of gas incurred by the Company. The Actual Monthly ICOG will be included on the Statement of Unbundled Transportation Service Cash Out Charges filed with the Commission by the fourth business day of the following effective month.

Average Daily Delivery Quantity (ADDQ) - The total quantity of gas the Customer <u>is required</u> by the Company to deliver each day to the Company. Such quantity shall be determined at least monthly by the Company and is subject to the limitations, restrictions, and other provisions contained herein.
