3.3 <u>CURTAILABLE ELECTRIC SERVICE</u> (Cont'd)

- a) The customer must be able to reduce his electric demand by at least 100 Kw. within a 2 hour notification period. The customer shall agree, in writing, to limit his electric demand to a specified Firm Power Level during curtailment periods. The Firm Power Level shall be agreed upon by both the customer and the Company. For any curtailment period during which the customer is unable to reduce his electric load for any part of the curtailment period to a level at or below the Firm Power Level, the customer shall be subject to additional charges as defined below.
- b) Service under this Special Provision shall be subject to curtailment between the hours of 8 AM and 10 PM.
- c) Curtailment periods shall be limited to a maximum of 18 occurrences per calendar year and not more than 8 hours per occurrence. Curtailments will be limited to no more one curtailment per day.
- d) The charges, credits and rating periods applicable under this Special Provision are the following:
