(L) Filing Requirements - Continued

(1) *Statement of Rates - Continued*

When the Interruptible or Off-Peak Firm Rate(s) changes on other than the first day of a month, the Company shall file with the Commission, not more than two (2) business days after the effective date, a statement showing the change(s), which shall remain in effect for the remainder of the month unless changed again.

All statements shall also include the currently effective Charges for Unauthorized Use, Capacity Release Service Rate, and the loss factor.

(2) *Statement of Balancing Service Charges and Statement of Monthly Cashout Credits and Charges*

All currently effective rates and charges, other than monthly cashout credits and surcharges for all Balancing Services applicable to this Service Classification shall be set forth on the "Statement of Balancing Service Charges". The Company will review the charges periodically and may adjust them to reflect changes in the Company's costs. Monthly cashout credits and charges applicable to the Load Following Service, Capacity Balancing Service, Daily Delivery Service, and the Monthly Balancing Service shall be set forth on the "Statement of Monthly Cashout Credits and Charges".

The statements will be filed with the Public Service Commission and will be available at customer service centers.
