SPECIAL PROVISIONS (Cont'd)

- 13.2 For customers who are taking transmission service and who are leasing substation equipment from the Company, measured billing units will be multiplied by 1.004 to recover demand and energy losses in the transformation system.
- 13.3 Any customer taking service under this Service Classification and who is not taking service under Special Provision 13.1 may elect to be billed at an expansion incentive rate, subject to the following:
 - a) An existing customer will not be eligible for the incentive rate until his maximum Kw. demand has increased by at least 100 Kw. over the maximum demand in the Base Year, defined below.
 - b) This incentive is available for industrial end manufacturing customers only.
 - If the customer qualifies, pursuant to the requirements above, the customer will be billed as follows: The customer's total Kwh consumed, during the current month will be divided by the total Kwh consumed in the base year, adjusted to the current month's number of billing days. The resulting ratio will determine the applicable charges, as indicated below.
 - (1) If this ratio exceeds 1.000, the customer will be billed for the usage during the same month of the base year at the customer, demand, energy and fuel cost adjustment charges specified above plus 90% of these charges times the usage in excess of the same month of the base year.
 - (2) If this ratio is less than .9500, the customer will be billed for 95% of the usage recorded by the Company in the same month of the base year at the regular charges specified under this Service Classification.
 - (3) If this ratio is between .9500 and 1.000, the customer will be billed for actual usage recorded in the current month at the regular charges specified under this Service Classification.
