18.4 ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION DISCOUNT (Cont'd)

Qualifying Locations

Locations which qualify for the discount will be identified by the Company and updated every six months. A list of qualifying locations will be provided to the Public Service Commission and the New York State Department of Economic Development.

Customers will not be eligible to commence taking service under this Special Provision after June 30, 2001.

18.5 POWER FOR JOBS

Eligibility

Service under this special provision will only be available to customers who receive an allocation of power under the Power for Jobs program. A Power for Jobs allocation is power and energy made available by the New York Power Authority (PASNY) to the Company for resale to designated Customers in accordance with Chapter 316 of the 1997 Laws of New York.

Application for Service

A customer who receives an allocation of Power for Jobs must have an account established under the Company's tariff. PASNY must advise the Company when a Power for Jobs allocation has been approved and provide the Company with a copy of the Allocation Contract. The notification by PASNY to the Company that the Customer has received a Power for Jobs allocation shall constitute the acceptance and the terms and conditions of this special provision. Notification of the Power for Jobs allocation shall state: 1) the delivery date, 2) the delivery amount, 3) identification of the Power for Jobs award as load growth or load retention, and 4) PASNY statement of customer eligibility.

All Power for Jobs Service provided under this provision must be transmitted and delivered into the Company's distribution system pursuant to the provisions of the Company's Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) filed with and accepted by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, as that OATT may be changed or modified from time to time.
