RATES

Central Hudson Delivery Service

The rates and charges for the Company's delivery of Power for Jobs capacity and energy are as follows:

In addition customers will be billed the estimated charges for PASNY capacity, including competitively bid power, and transmission of PASNY power to the Company's system. The energy charge per Kwh per month will be equal to the estimated PASNY charge for energy for Power for Jobs service. Both the capacity and energy charges shall be inclusive of any losses and any minimum bill obligation, and any applicable taxes incurred by the Company and not otherwise included in the foregoing rates.

Power for Jobs customers will be subject to a monthly adjustment per Kwh to reflect variances between estimated and actual charges for PASNY capacity, including competitively bid power and transmission of PASNY power to the Company's system, inclusive of losses and any minimum bill obligation and any applicable taxes incurred by the Company and not otherwise reflected in the foregoing charges.

In addition to the charges above, Central Hudson will bill a customer charge of \$25.00 per month, exclusive of increase in rates and charges to cover incremental billing and administrative costs associated with providing service to a Power for Jobs customer.

Minimum Charge

The minimum charge per month shall be the sum of the customer charges described above.
