<u>Determination of Energy and Demand Billing</u> (Cont'd)

- 3. The portion of the customer's monthly metered on-peak and off-peak energy to be billed at the Power For Jobs rates will be the product of the appropriate Billing Ratio times both the customer metered on-peak and off-peak energy.
- 4. The balance of the Customer's total registered demand and energy will be supplied and billed by the Company at the appropriate rates and charges of this Service Classification. The demand to be billed shall be the product of one minus the Power for Jobs ratio and the total demand for the month. The energy to be billed shall be the product of one minus the Power for Jobs ratio and the total kilowatt-hours for the month.
- 5. For a fractional part of a billing period at the beginning or end of service under this special provision, or for fractional periods due to a withdrawal or other change in the Customer's Power for Jobs allocation, the capacity charge and portion of any applicable minimum charge and the amount of energy that will be billed to the Customer under this special provision shall each be proportionately adjusted based on the ratio of the total hours of service under this special provision to the total number of hours in the billing period.
