LARGE POWER PRIMARY SERVICE (Cont'd)

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Bills are due when personally served or three days after mailing. Bills shall be subject to a late payment charge in accordance with General Information, Section 16, if payment is not made by the date specified on the bill which date shall be not less than 20 days from the due date.

TERM

A minimum of one year from March 15, 1978, or from commencement of service under this classification after that date, and successive annual terms thereafter. A customer cannot resume service within one year at the same location under this classification if service has been taken during the intervening period under any other service classification.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The numbering of the paragraphs hereunder begins with the above service classification number.

- 3.1 Any customer, who (a) qualifies to take service under this Service Classification and (b) is using the service in a new facility, which commenced construction after the effective date of this provision and which is located in an industrial park of at least 40 acres and which is zoned and planned for multiple industrial occupancy with such park having received preliminary approval of site development, including any required common road, water and sewer services, by all governmental authorities having jurisdiction over land use or which is located on New York State property in or adjacent to Stewart International Airport, will be billed for demand and energy at 90% of the monthly rate specified above for a period of sixty months from the date service commences after which the customer will be billed at full rates under this Service Classification. These charges shall be subject to a fuel cost adjustment as explained in General Information, Section 29.

Customers will not be eligible to commence taking service under this Special Provision after December 31, 1989.
