Customers may be required to pay an annual minimum charge commensurate with the level of service provided by the Company. The minimum charge and minimum transportation quantity associated with the minimum charge, will be specified in the customer's service agreement. Minimum charges will be computed to recover, all or a portion of the Company's carrying costs associated with incremental facilities, and other costs required to provide service to the customer, and a contribution to fixed costs. In determining the cost of incremental facilities related to serving customers under this service classification, the Company will consider costs incurred to install new facilities, costs related to upgrading existing facilities and future costs that are expected to be incurred due to the customer's absorption of existing system capacity.

Negotiated contracts a similar over terms shall be available to all similarly situated customers. Summaries of contract information will be available in Contract Addenda contained in this Tariff.

Rate TS-5n (Interruptible Service Transportation - Individually Negotiated):
