The Company shall establish for each day a "Daily Capacity Balancing Quantity" ("DCBQ") that the Seller will be obligated to deliver to a production area receipt point. The DCBQ in each month will be determined by the Company based on the Customers's actual historical or estimated gas use for that month, adjusted for normal weather. The Company may require the Seller to reduce deliveries on one or more days during a month to prevent surplus deliveries where the temperature is projected to be warmer than normal within the temperature parameters as explained in the Company's Sales and Transportation Operating Procedures.

**(3) Daily Delivery Service:**

Firm Customers or an aggregated group of Firm Customers supplied by Seller shall select either the Prior Day Notification Option or the Same Day Notification Option.

Notification Options:

**(a) Prior Day Notification:**

The Company shall establish for each day a quantity ("Daily Load Quantity or "DLQ") that the Customer's Seller shall be obligated to deliver to the Receipt Point on the *following* gas day for the Firm Customer's gas account as explained in the Company's Sales and Transportation Operating Procedures.
