Deliverability Demand Components

Customers taking service under Service Classification No. 6 will be charged the following demand related charges as defined in General Information, Section 41. The Customer's applicable billing determinants will be provided upon request as defined in General Information, Section 41.

(1) <u>Peaking Service Surcharge</u>

The peaking service surcharge rate 100 cu. ft. will be applied to the Customer's peaking service billing determinant. The peaking service rate will be equivalent to the per unit cost of peaking services under contract to Central Hudson, increased by the allowance for bad debt, Case 00-G-1273.

(2) Storage Service Surcharge

The storage service surcharge rate per 100 cu. ft. will be applied to the Customer's storage service billing determinant. The storage service rate will be equivalent to the per unit cost of storage services under contract to Central Hudson, increased by the allowance for bad debt, Case 00-G-1274.

(3) Storage Space Surcharge

The storage space surcharge rate per 100 cu. ft. will be applied to the Customer's storage space billing determinant. The storage space rate will be equivalent to the per unit cost of storage space under contract to Central Hudson, increased by the allowance for bad debt, Case 00-G-1274.

(4) <u>Capacity Release Surcharge</u>

If a customer or their Retail Supplier chooses to take assignment of the upstream pipeline capacity under contract to the Company the customer will be charged for that service through the Capacity Release Surcharge. The capacity release surcharge rate per 100 cu. ft. will be applied to the sum of the Customer's Daily Contract Quantity and the Customer's Incremental Daily Contract Quantity. The capacity release rate will be equivalent to the per unit cost of upstream capacity under contract to Central Hudson, increased by the allowance for bad debt, Case 00-G-1274.
