Part II

General Rules, Regulations, Terms, and Conditions, etc.

1. PROVISION OF GAS SERVICE BY THE COMPANY

A. Definitions:

Unless the context otherwise requires, the following definition shall apply to this part:

- I. main pipeline located on a public or private right-of-way which is generally available or used to transport gas to more than one service line.
- ii. service line piping, including associated metering and pressure reducing appurtenances, that transports gas below grade from a main to the first accessible fitting inside the wall of a customer's building when a meter is located within the building; if a meter is located outside the building, the service line will be deemed to terminate at the outside of the building foundation wall.
- iii. public right-of-way territory limits of an street, avenue, road or way (other than a limited access thoroughfare) that is for any highway purpose under the jurisdiction of the State of New York or the legislative body of any county, city, town or village and is open to public use.
- iv. non-competitive one-time service offerings made on a time and materials basis will be provided at "cost".
