- (B) Capacity Release Service Continued
 - (4) Quantity:

A new or Converting Customer electing Capacity Release Service may select any quantity up to a maximum daily quantity tied to the Customer's winter peak usage ("Maximum Quantity"). For a Customer taking the Load Following Service or Daily Delivery Service, the Maximum Quantity shall be the historical average daily quantity during the Customer's winter peak month. For a Customer taking the Daily Cashout Service, the Maximum Quantity shall be the Customer's historical winter peak day quantity. The Company shall calculate and provide the Maximum Quantity to all Customers.

If a Customer does not select any quantity of Capacity Release Service, the Customer shall present documentation to the Company that there is in place one or more executed transportation contract(s) with one or more interstate pipeline(s) for 365 days of firm transportation to the Citygate dedicated to deliveries for the Customer's account for a term of one year. For the winter season (November-March), such transportation must be firm with primary delivery point capacity to the Citygate. The daily quantity in each season shall be equal to:

- (a) For a Customer taking the Load Following Service or Daily Delivery Service, the historical average daily quantity during the Customer's winter peak month (November through March) and the historical average daily quantity during the Customer's summer peak month (April through October).
- (b) For a Customer taking the Daily Cashout Service, the Customer's historical peak day quantity during the winter season (November through March) and the Customer's historical peak day quantity during the summer season (April through October).
