- (4) Charges for Unauthorized Use:

The Customer shall pay a charge of \$4.50 for each therm of Unauthorized Usage, which shall consist of:

- (a) all gas consumed by the Customer during a period when transportation is interrupted, and
- (b) any gas consumed by an Interruptible, Off-Peak Firm or Power Generation Customer in excess of the Daily Transportation Quantity, exclusive of the allowance for losses, on a day when the Company declares an OFO or the Company is curtailing or interrupting its Interruptible sales, Off-Peak Firm sales, or Power Generation Customers.

The payment of this amount shall not constitute liquidated damages nor impair the Company's right to any remedy to which it may be entitled for injury caused by a Customer's unauthorized overrun. Charges for Unauthorized Use shall not be recognized in the calculation of the minimum charge.

If a Customer is unable to switch from gas to its alternate fuel or energy source in accordance with this Service Classification and related Operating Procedures, and notifies the Company of such situation prior to or within one hour of implementation of the curtailment, the Customer shall be billed at one-half of the Charge for Unauthorized Use during the first four hours of curtailment. Thereafter, the Customer shall be billed at the full charge.

Charges for Unauthorized Use shall be increased by the applicable percentage for the Increase in Rates and Charges, in accordance with General Information Section VIII.
