Limitation of Availability

1) Pilot Program - Limited Waiver of Upstream Capacity Assignment.

Effective December 1, 1998, the Company implemented a pilot program which discontinued the mandatory assignment of some or all upstream capacity. This pilot program will remain in effect until October 31, 1999. Requests for non assignment of capacity release under Service Classification No. 11 - Load Aggregation will be honored up to a maximum of 84,000 Dth per day including 16,800 Dth per day reserved for residential customers until March 31, 1999.

On and after April 1, 1999, the pilot program will be subject to the Commission's Policy Statement in Case 97-G-1380 issued and effective November 3, 1998. The Company will discontinue the mandatory assignment of capacity upstream of CNG but will continue to assign CNG capacity through October 31, 1999.
