2. Miscellaneous Surcharges

- a. Utility Low Income Energy Efficiency Program (ULIEEP) Surcharge
The rates in this Service Classification shall be increased by the ULIEEP surcharge, as described in General Information Section 39.
- b. Take or Pay Recovery
Transportation rates shall be subject to a surcharge per Mcf as set forth in Section 38, General Information.
- c. Increase in Rates in Municipality Where Service is Supplied
All rates and charges under this Service Classification, including charges specified under the Special Provisions of this Service Classification and the Transportation Service Agreement, shall be increased pursuant to Section 35, General Information, to reflect the tax rates applicable within the municipality where the Public Assistance Customer is taking service.
- d. Transition Costs Associated with F.E.R.C. Order No. 636
The rates for service rendered pursuant to the Service Classification shall be subject to a monthly transition cost surcharge as described in General Information Sections 19.j. and k.
- e. Weather Normalization Adjustment
SC 20 rates shall be subject to a refund/surcharge as set forth in Section 36, General Information.
- f. Revenue Credit
All gas transported under this Service Classification shall be subject to the revenue credits identified in the Statement of Revenue Credits filed with the Commission.
- g. Stranded Capacity Cost Charge
All gas transported under this Service Classification shall be subject to the Stranded Capacity Cost Charge as described in General Information Section 42.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

1. Gas Quality

Gas delivered by the DSS Supplier must satisfy the quality specifications set forth in the Transportation Service Agreement. Deliveries must be made at an appropriate Company facility located within the Territory described in Part I of this Schedule, or at another point or points acceptable to the Company.
