G. Character of Service (continued)

4. Limitation of Service. The transportation gas must be for the Customer's own use at a single location and will not be re-metered, sub-metered, resold, assigned or otherwise disposed to another or others, except as provided in the Service Agreement.

Service rendered hereunder shall be for a single Customer at a single location. Individual agreements are required for each location.

5. In addition to the applicable interruptibility provisions stated above or in the Service Agreement, Gas transported hereunder may be interrupted due to Force Majeure emergencies to the extent of the Maximum Daily Delivery Quantity at the sole discretion of the Company at any time by prior oral or written notice to Customer, and customer shall thereupon discontinue service as ordered.

When the Company is in a short-term "Force Majeure" supply shortage with its supplier(s), the Company has the right to purchase the Customer's own gas supply. Unless otherwise agreed to under a Peak Shaving Agreement, the price paid will be the Company's weighted average commodity cost of gas from its supplier(s) for the month.
